General Regulations

El Jadida International Arabian Horse Title Show is organized by the *Association du Salon du Cheval (ASC)*, under the aegis of the ECAHO and in collaboration with the *Association Royale Marocaine des Eleveurs des Chevaux Pur Sang Arabe (ARMECPSA)* and the *Société Royale d'Encouragement du Cheval (SOREC)*. It is organized under the current ECAHO/EAHSC regulation 2025.

C – GENERAL CONDITIONS

C1. Admission and qualification of horses

The show is open to any Arabian horse registered in a recognized studbook on the date of registration and having obtained one of the following qualifications in 2025, 2024 and 2023:

- 1st to 5th place at the World Championship, an A Show, a GCAT show or B Show
- 1st to 5th place in Yearling class at the World Championship, a Title, an A Show or GCAT show
- 1st to 3rd place at a National Championship, C National, C International, European Shows or EAHGC Shows
- 1st to 2nd place at Specific Origin Shows

Horses registered in countries which are not Members of ECAHO must either qualify in an ECAHO affiliated show or may qualify at other shows accepted by the EAHSC, such as:

- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or “TOP TEN” at the US Nationals
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or a 1st place at the US Scottsdale Competition
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion in US “Regional” competitions
- 1st to 3rd place at the Arabian Breeders World Cup (former US Las Vegas show)
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or 1st to 3rd place in an Egyptian Event US
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or 1st to 3rd place in an official National Championship show

A quota per country may be set. Horse entries will be open from **Monday, July, 28th to Saturday, August ,30th, 2025 and** a selection committee will decide definitively on the entered horses.

The entries must be made only via:

The entry form must be signed and attached to the copy of the horse's passport, respecting the schedule below:

C2. Special conditions

* **Competitors from all countries:** The owner of each horse selected to participate in the Show of El Jadida 2025, will receive an allowance set at 3,000 euros per horse (three thousand euros), as a contribution to the cost related to the transport and the stay of the registered horse.

The allowances will be paid by bank transfer to the owners of the participating horses or their duly authorized

representatives (handwritten certificate signed by the principal), and this immediately after confirmation by the competent authorities of Morocco of the re-export of these horses. The organizers of the Show will not pay any additional fees or expenses incurred by participants.

C3. Commitments

Horse entries are free. The entry file consists of the following documents:

- The entry form, one copy per horse, on which is indicated the name of the handler in capital letters and must be signed by the owner of the horse or another authorized person;
- A copy of the horse's identification booklet or passport;
- The equine influenza vaccination certificate;
- A copy of the handler's passport or national identity card.
- A copy of Vet certificate Hereditary Disorders

Failing this, the organizers will not accept the entry. No change of ownership can be considered by the organizers after the closing date for entries.

C4. Responsibility

The organizers of El Jadida International Arabian Horse Show decline any liability for any accidents, material damage, illness or damage caused for and by a third party on the competition grounds and within the confines of the Show. Signing the entry form engages the owner's civil and criminal liability.

C5. Qualifying classes

Class 1: 1 year old fillies born in 2024

Class 2: 2 years old fillies born in 2023

Class 3: 3 years old fillies born in 2022

Class 4: Females 4 to 6 years old (2021-2019)

Class 5: Females aged 7 years and over

Class 6: 1 year old colts born in 2024

Class 7: 2 years old colts born in 2023

Class 8: 3 years old colts born in 2022

Class 9: Males 4 to 6 years old (2021-2019)

Class 10: Males aged 7 years and over.

The classification could be modified depending on the number and category of entries.

C6. Scoring during qualifying classes

Horses will be judged individually at the halt, walk and trot. Each judge will assign scores for type, head and neckline, body, legs and movements. The scoring system, out of 20 with ½ points will be adopted.

C7. "Open" Championship Rules

The top three horses in each category will be qualified to compete in their respective championship provided that there are at least five participants in the class. Otherwise, only the first two of the class will be qualified to participate in their championship.

The Gold, Silver or Bronze Champions may be selected by the judges from among any of the qualified horses of each category participating in the championships. Judging at the championships will be done in a comparative way by the entire jury of the Show:

- Rules for Yearlings, Juniors and Seniors Championships:

- A horse cited for the Gold medal by a judge obtains 4 points;
- A horse cited for the Silver medal by a judge obtains 2 points;
- A horse quoted for the Bronze medal by a judge obtains 1 point;
- The Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse that obtains the most votes from the judges;
- The silver medal will be awarded to the horse that has obtained the greatest number of points after the 1st.
- The Bronze medal will be awarded to the horse that has obtained the greatest number of points after the 2nd.

C8. Rule in the event of a tie

- Rules in the event of a tie in the qualifying classes

The best place is given to the horse that has the highest points for the type. If there is still a tie, the highest place is awarded to the horse with the highest gait score. If the ties cannot yet be decided, if a tie cannot yet be decided, one of the judges drawn must indicate his preference.

- Rules in the event of a tie in the Championships

The best place is given to the horse with the best score in the class. If there is still a tie, the same rule as for the qualifying classes will be applied.

All gold champions will be subject to a urine and/or blood sample for doping control according to the FEI regulations in force. However, if it deems it useful, the DC may have any other horse engaged in the competition removed for an anti-doping check.

C9. Handlers

Handlers must be over the age of 18, dressed in suitable attire, without any markings or distinctive features, and must be in possession of an ECAHO license in good standing.

The DC will scrupulously ensure compliance with the rules of ECAHO competitions in force (RCS), in particular, everything related to animal welfare (prohibition of plastic bags, etc.).

C10. Veterinary visit

All horses are subject to a veterinary visit before admission to the Show stables from **Sunday September 28th to Tuesday, 30th, 2025**.

Feeding the horses is in the charge of the owner. However, hay, straw, wood chips, as well as barley, oats and complete feed will be for sale on the site.

C11. Horse number

The horse number will be given to the handlers after the veterinary and the disciplinary committee control on **Tuesday, September 30th, 2025** from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The horses will be accompanied by their identification and health documents.

D – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

D1. Arrival and departure of horses

Horses must arrive no later than **Saturday 27th & Sunday 28th & Monday September 29th, 2025 before 4 PM** and must leave on **Friday, October 03th, 2025 from 10 AM**.

D2. Feeding

Feeding the horses is the responsibility of the owner. However, hay, straw, wood chips, as well as barley, oats and complete feed will be for sale on the site.

D3. Barns

A boxing area with litter will be reserved for the accommodation of horses on their arrival. A day and night security service will be provided, it is recommended that each person entitled to access the stables area have his access badge.

D4. Veterinary care, farriery

The ASC will provide emergency veterinary care on the site of Salon du cheval. Farriery services are the exclusive responsibility of the participants.

E – EQUIPMENT

E1. Qualifying classes:

- Winners: award plates
- 2nd place: award plaques
- 3rd to 5th place: plaques

E2. Championships:

- Special Trophies.
- Award plates

F – DIVERS

F1. Claims

Any complaint must be written and filed with the Disciplinary Committee, at the latest one hour after the facts and must be accompanied by an amount equivalent to 200 Euros in cash.

F2. Insurance

All participants must have their personal insurance valid. Horses and equipment remain under the participants' care and responsibility for their attendance at the Salon du Cheval d'El Jadida.

F3. Customs' formalities,

Each participant must take care, personally, of the transport of his horses and the expenses inherent in the administrative costs.

G – ACCOMMODATIONS

The participants in “title” Show, must provide themselves with their own conditions of stay, hotel reservation, meals and special transfers. A shuttle between Casablanca's Mohammed V International Airport and El Jadida could be set up. In order to benefit from this, participants are advised to send the organizers the number of people, the origin, the arrival times and the flight numbers.
